

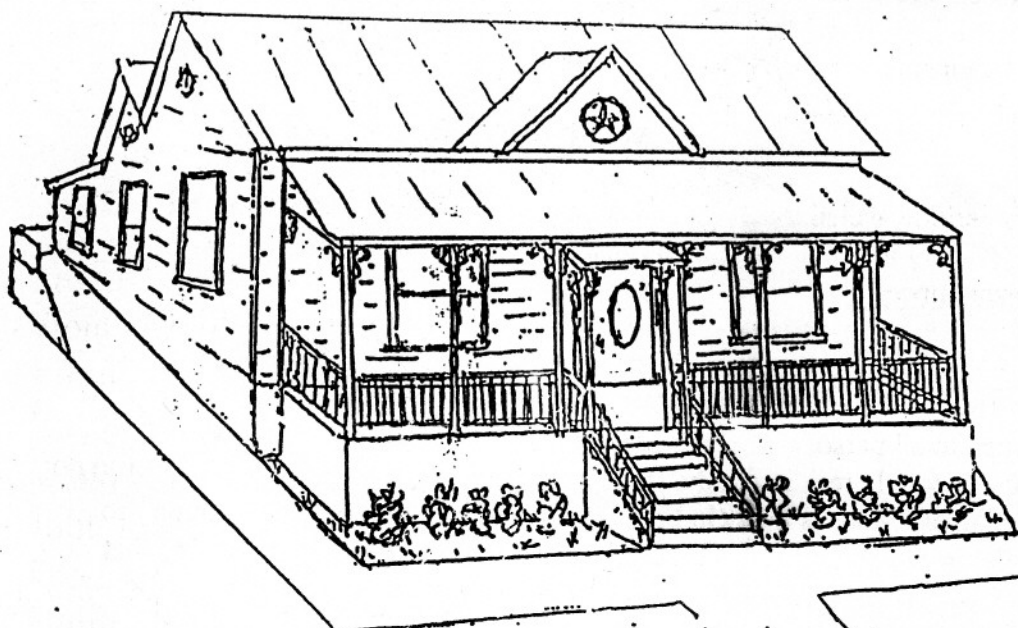

Ortsippenbuch and Dorfbuch to the rescue in family research

A researcher finding a village of origin has to determine whether an Ortsippenbuch or Dorfbuch has been published about the village.

An Ortsippenbuch is produced by a qualified historian or genealogist from the area of the village. He sifts through records that exist for the village church registers, tax list, censuses and etc. This information alphabetically organized by family and families numbered. These numbers are used to move from generation to generation and cross reference females into their own families. This can cross reference into other village books and some are able to take families into the 1500s.

Dorfbucher lists lines of descent within families or houses but more on the history of the village. Some villages go back eight hundred to a thousand years, filled with abstracts of early documents, photographs of historic houses and people of the village.

The best collection of these books are available at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints' Family History Library.

The Family History Library Catalog is available on Internet at www.familysearch.org. click on "Place Search" Also try www.google.com and feed in the name of the village.

In researching German marriage records, remember that in Germany a civil marriage is also obligatory and takes place at the local Standesamt (registrar's office) in the presence of two witnesses. The church wedding follows the civil ceremony, thus there may be not just one, but two records of a marriage, one civil and one church.

Family Research

Finding a Village

While Germany has its large urban areas, the nation and the many smaller states that preceded have always been collections of many villages. For the genealogist, this realization has a crucial impact since finding an immigrant ancestor's village of origin often is a challenge as well as the information that could unlock two or three centuries worth of pedigree.

While there are archives for larger political units than the village, some of the most useful record groups, such as church records, will be found at the level of a village – either the exact one your ancestor came from or a larger village that your ancestor's Heimat, or home, was a part of.

However, there are often substantial problems in identifying an immigrant ancestor's village of origin. First of all, most types of American records (even many passenger lists, United States Census, and naturalizations) will list the birthplace as "Prussia" or "Bavaria" instead of a village name. In this case, it is best to be methodical, that is, collecting every possible record about the immigrant in the hope that at least one will have a more detailed description. In addition, since many Germans either traveled with families from the same village or settled near them, always try to find the villages of others on the same ship or those listed near your ancestor in the United States Census or tax lists.

Another problem arises when the name of a village is handed down. Often, these names have been corrupted over time, and, in some

cases, villages have been absorbed by others and will not appear on modern-day maps. Another scenario is that the place name given is that of a large city such as Frankfurt, when indeed the immigrant just wanted to name a place people would know, instead of "Langenselbold, a small village near Frankfurt."

Finally, there is also the difficulty that there are often many identically named villages in Germany. Call this the "Burgheim" problem after two of the more common ending syllables of German place names. In this case, it can be helpful to have some other description attached such as a nearby river, other physical feature, or larger town.

So, these are the problems. What are the solutions? There are many resources, but two of the best are the *Meyer's Gazetteer* and the Internet German Genealogy Page village locator.

Meyer's Gazetteer is short for *Meyer's Orts-und Verkehrs-Lexikon der deutschen Reichs* (in English, *Meyer's Locality and Commercial Gazetteer of the German Empire*). This valuable publication was put out in 1912 on the eve of World War I. As a consequence, it contains entries for all the villages lost by Germany in the two World Wars. These entries contain listings for population, which churches were represented in the town and many additional details.

Meyer's Gazetteer is available on microform through the Family History Library and Family History Center system of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Copies can be found in major academic libraries.

GEOserv e-mail village locator sends information on modern-day German towns, returning results for "Altenberg" as shown above. Reading and interpreting the results is explained clearly on the German Genealogy.net home page.

On the German Genealogy.net page is a GEOserve e-mail service. You send an e-mail with the village name you are seeking (in the body copy of the email) and a 50,000-village database is searched. You are sent a reply by email with all sorts of information (longitude and latitude, if the town has been consolidated as part of a larger village, its county name, postal code, and much more.

I. "What's in Your Name?"

"Became Surname in 15th Century"

Trade names did not emerge fully as surnames until the 15th Century. Of all these names which stemmed from trades Schmidt (and the English counterpart Smith) is the most common, covering as it does a wide range of occupations.

One of the most important factors which spelled the doom of the ancient feudal lords and robber barons was the great Black Plague which killed off almost two thirds of the population of Europe in the 14th Century. Serfs who had labored for a pittance were called upon to serve their neighbors with their skills and crafts and the most lowly man achieved a measure of status and individuality.

The most important of these were the smiths and iron-workers. They fashioned objects for the household, shod the horses, created instruments which guarded the castles and struck the swords and armor which protected the knights.

The Schmidt surname is a direct development from the Germanic word used to describe one engaged as a worker in the blacksmiths shop, but this did not take place until the turn of the 15th Century. In ancient German records prior to 1400 the appearance of Schmidt did not indicate a surname, nor did the alternatives Smyth, Smit or Smith. In England where surnames evolved earlier than in Germany the term was more likely to be found written in the Latin equivalent Farber.

Schmidt is so universally scattered throughout Europe it is difficult to continue research to any one branch, however through the records find many titled personages ranging from Chevalier to Baron.

Grants of arms have been made to the name in many different locations including Prussia, Silesia, Saxony, Hanover, Bavaria, Franconia, Austria, Switzerland, Holland, Sweden, Transylvania, to mention but a few.

Two of the most important Schmidts in the United States were clergymen. Henry Immanuel Schmidt was licensed as a Lutheran clergyman and was an assistant professor in Hartwick Seminary, N.Y. He was also a professor of German and French in Pennsylvania college.

Frederick Augustus Schmidt, born in Leutenberg, Germany, was professor in the Norwegian Luther college at Decorah, Iowa.

John Friedrich Behr

John Friedrich Behr, a subject of the King of Hanover, arrived at the port of New York on January 25, 1851, at the age of 26 years. He was born December 11, 1830 and died September 14, 1897 and was married August 28, 1853 to Sophie Brandes born June 14, 1830 in Hanover, Germany and died January 13, 1905 in Texas.

John Friedrich received his citizenship on November 25, 1858 and was listed in the 1860 census of Gillespie County, Texas.

Frontier Experiences of Julius Kott

The fields of Gillespie county, cultivated by modern machinery, and the stock farms, where thoroughbred cattle and hogs, Angora goats and Merino sheep are found, differ vastly from the unfenced wilderness in which German immigrants settled. It was on a 320 acre grant of land on Bear Creek about 16 miles from Fredericksburg, 7 miles from the nearest neighbor, that Ernst Kott, the father of Julius Kott settled with his family. The land then, was infested by wild animals, and still occasionally visited by Comanches and Delawares, who used it for their hunting grounds.

In Saxony Ernst Kott was a book binder, skilled at his trade. Although none of his children learned the trade from him, they still have a number of books that he bound. The glowing accounts of the new land that reached the bookbinder in Saxony stirred him to a new land and Ernst Kott with his wife and children sailed for America in 1854.

Julius, the fourth child, was four years old when the journey was made. His earliest memory is an indefinite impression of being on a ship--he was told in later years that it was on the North Sea--in the midst of a dense fog when suddenly from out of the white mist came a great ear-splitting noise, the fog horn of another vessel, perilously close. He remembers that his father snatched him up from the deck and carried him swiftly down several steps to the cabin where the others of the family were assembled.

Julius Kott is now 82 years old. During the 78 years he has spent in Gillespie county he has had, as part of his everyday life, many interesting experiences. He recalls them vividly and with remarkable accuracy.

One of the earliest experiences that he recalls is of being taken to see a sick Indian, whom the settlers held captive. This occurred before the family of Ernst Kott had settled at Bear Creek. After their arrival from Germany the family for a short while lived at the place on the Pedernales, where Dr. William Keidel had settled. Dr. Keidel had been the one to lead the settlement of farms at Pedernales, promising all of those who would go with him to settle there, that he would treat their ailments without charge. Later Dr. Keidel was married to one of the daughters of Ernst Kott.

It was while Kotts were still on Dr. Keidel's place that the Indian was captured. The death of this Indian at the hands of the German settlers, a number of old pioneers still recall with regret.

At the Emil Wahrmond home at Bear Creek not far from where the Pedernales school house stands, a lone Indian appeared one morning. Mrs. Wahrmond, stepping out of the house early in the morning, saw the Indian standing in the yard. Her screams called her husband, who picked up the ax. But the Indian dodged, prateeting himself behind Mrs. Wahrmond. He dropped his bow and arrow to show that he was giving himself up. He was a young Indian, probably a Comanche, who could speak to them only with signs. There was no doubt that he was sick. For several days he stayed in the yard, sitting listlessly about in the shade, quite impassive to the people who called by at the Wahrmond home for a look at the Indian.

Julius Kott remembers that his father took him and his brothers to see the Indian. By the side of the Indian lay his bow and arrow. The father picked up[the bow, the leather string of which was quite slack. The father, fingering it, remarked to his boys, that this bow would not shoot far. Julius remembers how the Indian took the bow from Mr. Kott's hand, gave it one deft twist against his knee, and handed it back with the string now so taut, that it vibrated to the touch.

After a few days the Indian was taken to town. Here there was much speculation concerning him. Some of the people believed that he was sick; others feared that his illness was only pretended, that he was a spy, who would presently betray the people of the settlement to his tribe. In spite of the protests and pleading of many of the people, the young Indian was taken out of town a mile or so, tied to a tree and shot.

From, Germany Ernst Kott brought several; guns, pistols, and a two-barrel shot gun, that like the guns of that day must be loaded from the muzzle. This delay was inconvenient and often dangerous. Before the gun could be reloaded, powder from a powder horn must be poured into the gun, then paper wadded in, and lastly a bullet wedged in.

Many a night the father and boys sat with loaded guns in their log house, expecting an attack from the Indians who prowled about. The barking dogs, scenting strange, fearful human beings would go only so far, before they came sneaking back to the house. From the pasture near the house came strange weird calls, something like those of an owl, answered now from this direction and then from that. And the family knew that Indians were signaling one another.

The morning after these visits the family usually discovered that horses had been stolen and often that a section of the picket fence about the field was down. If it was the season for roasting ears, a patch of the cornfield was raided, and in water-melon season, they found water-melons cut open and left in the field.

At one time the father was about a mile away from the house when he spied two Indians. One of them was on horseback, the other holding on to the ankle of the rider was running alongside of the horse. Mr. Kott, who carried his shot gun, raised it to fire, but something restrained him. He never regretted that he did not fire, for the Indians never made a move to attack him or any of his family; but if he had fired, the story of his family might have taken a different ending, for the Indians were revengeful creatures.

During their first years at Bear Creek, the father and older boys were out in the pasture getting logs for rail fences, leaving the mother and smaller children at home for one day, when the mother, leaving the house, noticed figures on a nearby hill. The hill was too far away for the mother to discern whether or not the figures were Indians, but she could see that they were people, who moved about, peering now this way and then that, seeming especially interested in the house. The mother went back into the house. When she came out again she was wearing a suit and hat of her husband and carrying a gun. She walked resolutely and openly about in the yard, until presently she laid her gun aside and began to chop wood. After she had chopped wood a while, she glanced back up to the hill. The figures were gone. Next day, when they went up the hill to investigate, they found there the flat-footed, moccasined tracks of Indians.

One of the nearest escapes that any of the family had from Indians occurred also during the first years that the family lived here. All about them lay untilled government and that

anyone might use. The father and sons cleared a field of this government land about three miles from the house on the bank of Bear Creek. They plowed it with oxen and planted it. The father and one of the sons, Richard, had been working in the field all day. They had loaded the last of the hay and were on the way home, Richard sitting up on the wagon driving, his father walking behind the wagon carrying a little tin lunch pail. Suddenly from behind they heard a horse neigh. At this unexpected sound the father experienced a prick of fear. He turned, and saw across the field on the opposite bank of Bear Creek, seven Indians on horseback. As they watched, the Indians disappeared down a narrow trail, leading down from the bank.

As the Indians came riding across the field toward the wagon, the leader waved his hand at the man and boy, motioning them to leave the wagon. Richard and his father fled quickly across the field and into the thicket. When they reached home, they armed themselves and with neighbors started to trail the Indians. In the field they found the hay wagon where they had left it, but the horses and mule that had been hitched to it were gone, as well as all the leather from the harness. Next morning the old mule, still wearing his collar came back home, but of the other horse and the Indians, they found no trace.

When Julius Kott was seventeen or eighteen years old he and his younger sister wanted to go to a Fourth of July dance at Fredericksburg. They were ready, their horses saddled, but occasional showers all through the day had left them undecided whether or not they should go. At last their father expressed a decided opinion of people who would venture out on such a night, and the horses were unsaddled and turned into the pasture.

That night the Indians made a raid, and the next morning the two horses six or seven mules had disappeared. However, in the mud, the tracks of the Indians were easily traced. The boys, following them for a distance, came upon the sorrel, which Julius had recently acquired, and of which he was fond. The sorrel was standing near a clump of trees, an arrow in its flank. They drove the horse home, but it was a long time before they could use him again; for the arrow had been poisoned. The Indians, when they found that a horse would not follow, or when so closely pursued that captured seemed certain, usually shot the stolen horses with poisoned arrows.

The play of the children was influenced by their life. While Julius and another brother were still quite small, they made themselves long spears, at the point of which they inserted a sharp nail. They threw these spears or javelins at tree trunks until their aim became good. Then one day in the pasture, they saw one of the little pigs belonging to their father. Just to try his aim, the brother threw his spear at the pig. His aim was so good that the spear struck the pig in the forehead, and it died.

By the time that he was twelve years old, Julius was accustomed to carrying a pistol, a precaution that was necessary, not only as protection against Indians, but also against wild animals. It happened that several nights in succession an animal came up to the pigs that rooted outside of the year fence, and a great squealing ensued. The barking dogs, when urged on, only drew back with bristling hair. One night at one o'clock they heard the noise again, and then heard that a pig was being carried away.

The father seized his shot-gun and Julius his pistol, they called the dogs and followed. When they came to a large live-oak, the huge branches of which curved almost to the ground, the dogs suddenly stopped, pointing their noses toward the branches. Up in the

branches a dark object was discernible. The father fired his shot-gun, and Julius his pistol twice. That was all of the ammunition.

The father told his son to stay near the dogs and watch, while he hurried home to reload his gun. Trembling, Julius hid behind the trunk of the tree and watched the animal up in the tree. And suddenly he knew what it was, for he heard the blood curdling screams of a wounded panther. The forebody of the animal dropped, so that he hung to the branch by his hind legs. Then another leg swung free, and the panther hung from one leg. In a moment the animal had dropped to the ground. The dogs pounced upon it, just as the father arrived. They found upon examining the dead panther, that it was a large animal, fully grown, and that he had been wounded twice. For years afterwards they cherished the lovely soft fur of the panther that they skinned the next day.

During the early 60's Julius Kott attended school in Fredericksburg, the pupil of Schoolmaster Schuetze, who several years later was victim of the "Hanger Bande." At the outbreak of the Civil War, Herman, the oldest son of Ernst Kott enlisted in the Southern army. He never returned from war, meeting his death at Mansfield, La.

It was while he was attending school in town that Julius Kott really saw some Indians. A tribe of more than 400 had been captured. Mr. Kott thinks that they were probably Kickapoos. The soldiers, who were taking them to the reservation, stopped with them in Fredericksburg. For several hours they covered the market square. There were squaws with papooses in cradles, red-skinned children, warriors with bows and arrows, and a chief in gorgeous, glittering array. Mr. Kott remembers the beaded and brilliantly colored feathered head band of the chief. No sooner had the Indians stopped in town, than some of them began a begging tour from house to house. When it was time to leave town, it was not the soldiers who summoned the Indians, but their chief. He lifted a curious little whistle to his lips, and at the shrill, piercing call, the Indians came running from all directions.

Julius Kott was married to Hedwig Schmidt in 1872. A year or two after their marriage they moved to Comfort. Before they went to Comfort to make their home, they went to visit their brother, Richard Kott, who lived there. Mr. Kott's sister Alma, now Mrs. Otto Schmidt, accompanied them in the wagon pulled by two yoke of oxen. The women rode in the wagon, while Mr. Kott walked along by the side, guiding the oxen with his whip. When they came to a creek not far from Comfort, he cracked the whip, and the cliffs that bordered the creek answered with an echo.

Suddenly the bushes parted, and a woman, brandishing a butcher knife came out, screaming frantically "Indianer! Indianer!"

She told them that she was completely surrounded by Indians, that they were hiding in every bush, lurking behind every tree. Mr. Kott investigated, but found no Indians. The woman, still clutching her butcher knife, climbed into the wagon with Mr. Kott's wife and sister, who were more frightened at the knife, than at the prospect of meeting Indians. They told the woman that if she did not get out with her knife they would leave the wagon. The woman told them that if they left the wagon, she, too, would leave, and go with them.

So all three of them descended from the wagon. As they walked along behind the plodding oxen, she relinquished the knife and became calmer. As she talked to them, they realized why she was at times half crazy with fear. Some years before, her son had been

carried away by the "Haenger Bande." When after several days he had not returned, the mother and sister went in search of him. The shock of finding his dead body, made the sister extremely ill, and half crazed the mother.

Although Mr. and Mrs. Julius Kott were both little more than children at the outbreak of the civil war, they both remember the outrages of the "Haenger Bande." Heinrich Herman, a brother-in-law of Mrs. Kott's, who was murdered in 1872, was one of the last victims of his band of outlaws.

Mr. Kott remembers another trip to Comfort just as eventful. Shortly after they had moved to Comfort, he went home for a few days. On his return his sister accompanied him to Comfort. This time they went on horseback. When they came to a high hill half way between their home and Comfort, they saw a queer black object on top of the hill. It looked something like a pig. Mr. Kott was eager to find out what it was. His sister, fearful of Indians, begged him not to go. But Mr. Kott assuring her that Indians would no longer come so close to the settlements, left her with the horses, while he took the gun and climbed the hill. On top of the hill, in a little clearing between a grove of live oaks, a black bear was sitting upon its haunches. Mr. Kott fired, and the bear went running down the other side of the hill. Mr. Kott followed, until the bear entered a ravine at the foot of the hill. Remembering that his had heard the shot, and would be frightened. Mr. Kott decided not to pursue it farther. He went up the hill the way he had come. When he again entered the clearing on top, he saw in the branches of the live oak two little cubs. He fired twice and two cubs tumbled down. Then to his surprise, he saw coming out of the brush a fourth bear, this one quite lean. After he had killed his bear, he cut the hind quarters off the three bears.

At the home of his brother Richard they were threshing the next day. He took the bear meat on to his brother's home. When at dinner, the meat was placed on the table, the threshers were asked to guess at what kind of meat they were eating.. Someone guessed that it was pork steak. There was good laugh at this guess after the dinners had been told the bear story.

After living for eight years at Comfort, they returned to their former home on Bear Creek. There Mr. and Mrs. Kott lived until they moved to town twelve years ago. Some of Mr. and Mrs. Kott's children and some of their nephews are still living on the land that was wilderness when Ernst Kott settled it nearly seventy-eight years ago.

Heinrich Kleaner, a Minute Man

As Pioneer Citizens pass on, the accounts of the experiences, which they have repeated many times to grandchildren often die with them. Mr. Heinrich Klaerner, however, not long before his sudden death on April 3, 1931, permitted a written account of his experiences to be made. Sitting in the wooden lawn swing at the home of his son-in-law

and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Charles Kuenemann, he grew entertainingly reminiscent of his days as Minute Ranger and teamster at Fort Concho.

Born at Live Oak on July 27, 1855, he grew up in that community, where he and his brothers, as children, often found prowling Indians slipping between the trunks of pecan and oak trees.

In 1873 he became a member of Captain Lacey's Company F. Minute Rangers, whose headquarters were at Spring Creek, Gillespie county, where Captain Lacey lived. Because Captain Lacey was an old man, his son-in-law, Ben Keese, was appointed assistant captain. There were twenty men in the company, some of whom are still living in the county. John Menges acted as guide, walking ahead to trace the path of Indians. In this company the men were furnished only windchester and ammunition.

When in 1875 Captain Kelland's company of Texas Rangers was organized, Captain Lacey's company disbanded, and most of the men joined Captain Kelland's company, which numbered 40 men. In this company the men were furnished uniforms like those of the soldiers, a suit of heavy blue cloth, trimmed with yellow buttons.

The Minute Rangers were permitted to remain at their homes, but they must be ready on a minute's notice to take up the trail of marauding Indians. They were the regular Texas Rangers, and although they usually covered only the surrounding counties, they might have been called anywhere in Texas.

The Indians whose chief aim in coming to the settlements, was to steal horses, usually rode the stolen horses away. When Rangers pursued them closely, they rode so fast that the horses were soon worn out. When this occurred, the horses were killed with poisoned arrows, and the Indians continued their escape on foot. In the dense underbrush it was more difficult than ever for the Rangers to catch them.

Although Company F. was not large in number, the men who comprised it were, young adventurous and foolhardy where danger was concerned. Each one had his mind set on the \$50. reward that the state government offered as bounty for the scalp of an Indian who was out of the reservation, molesting settlers.

Captain Lacey often found it necessary to restrain their eagerness to rush into battle with the Indians. At one time, they traced a band of Indians up to Squaw Creek, and found where the Indians had gone up a nearby hill. The Rangers were eager to divide themselves into two groups, cut off the escape of the Indians and lead them into battle. But Captain Lacey, because the number Rangers present was small, would not consent.

Years later, Mr. Klaerner learned that while the Rangers were below the hill, discussing the attack, the Indians were on top of the hill, watching them. With the Indians on the hill was Adolph Fischer, who as a boy was captured by the Indians from his home on the Pedernales. He often accompanied the Indians on these trips, even helping them steal horses, but he always insisted that they must not kill anyone. When, years later he returned to Fredericksburg from a visit, he and Mr. Klearner marveled at how near they came to going into battle against one another.

At another time, Mr. Klaerner was in a thicket not far from his parents home, where he had just shot a wild turkey, when he heard a noise in the bushes. He turned, expecting to see a wild animal. Instead he saw two Indians on a horse. They had heard the shot, but had not yet spied Klaerner. He drew back into the bushes, loaded his gun and waited.

Almost at once he heard a disturbance on the other side, and realized That he was almost

surrounded by Indians. There was nothing to do, but keep very still and hope that they would not discover him. Presently he heard them move on, and knew that they had met not far away from him.

He hurried home with his turkey and alarmed the neighbors. Soon they were on the trail of the Indians. Here and there along the trail they found scraps of meat, and now and then a picket fence into which the Indians had torn a gap to a shorter path. Near Doss August Lang met them and told them that a band of thirteen or fourteen Indians were meeting not far away. The pursuers hastened there, but they were too late to find the Indians. They followed the trail, once on the banks of Sandy, coming so close to the Indians that they found a butchered calf, still warm, that the Indians had killed and left.

Protecting the settlers from Indians was not the only duty of the rangers. They had also the cattle rustlers to deal with. On one occasion they were sent up the James River into Kimble county to arrest a cattle thief. They found his house in order, no stolen cattle about, and not a trace of the rustler himself. Although he was generally believed to be a cattle thief, he foiled every attempt of the Rangers to catch him with stolen cattle. Some time later, when the Rangers were in a cedar thicket near Sonora, where they planned to make a bear hunt, they noticed a thread of smoke rising out of the dense thicket. They crept nearer cautiously, for they expected to find Indians about the fire. They were astonished at the sight that met their eyes. There was only one person to be seen, an old man, who sat by the fire, cooking something in a large black pot. The fire was built in a large clearing in the thicket, which evidently served as a corral. It was fenced about by cedar trees, which had been partly cut, and then bent over, so as to make an impenetrable wall. Here and there lay a cow, whose leg had been broken, or a calf that had been trampled on and killed. Over at the side were great stacks of cowhides. The Rangers surmised that they had stumbled upon the corral, where stolen cattle were kept. Mr. Klaerner and two others approached the old man and asked questions concerning the ownership of the outfit. The old man readily told the name of the owner, and the Rangers whistled softly in surprise. It seemed now that they might have proof that the suspected thief was indeed a cattle rustler. But the old man could tell them little more. He was only the cook, he said. He did not know when the outfit would return.

The Rangers made camp not far away. It was not until the next morning that they heard the lowing of cattle and the stamping of hoofs. Captain Lacey rode into the corral, where he found more than a dozen cowboys all well armed with pistols and windchesters. They hooted at his demand that they give up the cattle.

Captain Lacey rode back to his men, stationing them in the brush surrounding the corral. He gave them command to shoot at his signal, which was to be a whistle on a cartridge shell. Once more he rode into the corral. He demanded that the cattle be given up. If they had not been surrendered at the end of 20 minutes, his company of Rangers would open fire. The cowboys hesitated. They gathered in consultation, and then suddenly giving a wild whoop, wheeled their horses about and were off.

The Rangers found cattle of many different brands in the herd. They cut out the cattle of familiar brands, drove the herd on to Junction, and turned them loose. Many of the cattle then drifted back to their own ranges.

Although he was supposed to be under arrest, the cattle rustler was never caught. Several years later, after Mr. Klaerner was out of Ranger service, he was watching horse races at

the Braeutigam place, which is near the Fredericksburg tourist park, when he saw a man sitting under a tree alone, counting gold. Mr. Klaerner slipped up closer. As he recognized the cattle rustler, he uttered a surprised, "Hello!" and called the man by name. Instantly the man was upon his feet, thrusting his gold into his pocket. He was upon his horse and away, without saying a word.

After he was out of Ranger Service, Mr. Klaerner was a teamster at Fort Concho, taking supplies to the commissary of the fort. He accompanied by army to the first post, when General McKenzie and 700 soldiers, mostly negroes, marched out to the plains to capture the Comanches and take them up into the Indian Reservation. As they marched out of Fort Concho located at San Angelo, the military band played. The officers of higher rank rode in a hack. Following the infantry came the mule teams, that carried the ammunition and supplies. Although they were twelve mules to each team, they were so well trained that they needed only a check line for the leaders to guide them.

The soldiers captured 350 Comanche women and children, and several Lipans, whom the Comanches had captured previously. The Comanche men were hard to capture because they knew the country and carried long range buffalo guns, that could shoot as far as a mile. Several soldiers were killed in the skirmish.

Before they were taken on to the Reservation, the captured Indians were kept at Fort Concho, for several months. It was hoped that there in a large corral, they might, with the aid of an interpreter, be partly civilized first. But the women resented the imprisonment, and quarreled among themselves. game of cards, with cards that they had traded from Mexicans, and when in their game they became enraged, bit one another.

The Comanche children were all good shots with bow and arrow. Often Mr. Klaerner saw a boy, lying in the shade of a tree, take up his bow and arrow and shoot a bird in a nearby tree. Then the boy seized eagerly at his prey, picked it off its feathers, and ate it that way. The men carried shields through which arrows, even some bullets could not penetrate. The shields were made of quills of feathers, piled one upon the other, several inches in thickness.

Sometimes Mr. Klaerner watched them decorate buffalo hides, in bright designs of red, yellow and blue. First the hides were scraped with knives, then to soften them washed in yucca root, which made a marvelously soaplike foam. Then, when they were dry, the hides were painted. For the red color they used the insect which lives on prickly pear, for yellow they used algerita root. Mr. Klaerner could not discover how they procured their blue dye. They were then ready to be traded off.

Altogether the Comanches did not care to sell the hides, or the moccasins and the beautifully beaded scabbards they wore, they were always ready to trade them for tobacco. Mr. Klaerner once offered to trade a plug of tobacco, which was worth 50cents, for the moccasins a squaw was wearing. She raised ten fingers, to show that she would trade for ten plugs of tobacco. The trade was not made.

Although the Rangers were promised a salary, they had, several years after they were out of service, not received any money. At last, Mr. Klaerner, together with several others of the Ranger company and a school teacher, Mr. Ulrich, went to the old capitol at Austin, to make complaint. The officials in charge looked over the record, but found no mention of their company. Clerks were called in to investigate further and finally among old

documents was located a record of their services, entitling them to three years back pay, and a pension.

Not all Rangers were so fortunate. John Durst, deceased several years ago, served all through the civil war as a Ranger. But by mistake his name went on the records as John Hurst. Others of his company received pension in later years, but although John Durst made repeated attempts to convince officials that he was John Durst of the company he never received his pension.

The life of the Ranger was not an easy one. He must be ready on a minute's notice to be gone for days carrying only his gun, his blanket and a few biscuits. There was always meant enough, wild turkey, deer and antelope, but his fare grew tiresome. He slept on his blanket on the ground. Mr. Klaerner recalled that often he picked grass to make a softer bed. In winter he awoke sometimes to find his blanket frozen stiff, so that he could set it up like a tent.
